MEMORANDUM:

KABUL, AFGHANISTAN

In the interest of peace, RACCOON TECHNOLOGIES INCORPORATED will honor the peace agreement made if any with the ISLAMIC EMIRATE OF AFGHANISTAN, conditional compliance with the UNIFORM DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS so already a treaty signed and made Supreme Law of the United States.

These terms prohibit forced marriage, threat to coerce child sexual abuse, and prohibition against the execution or injury of those who do not agree with or comply with SHARIA LAW; as is the human right of every person in Afghanistan.

We have received reports that Taliban soldiers are coercing women to marry under color of protection.

While the UNITED STATES, a government, is obligated to the respect of other nations, and RACCOON TECHNOLOGIES INCORPORATED is a commissioned franchise of the same in INTERSTATE BUSINESS, this firm will uphold all agreements made by the lawful administration on foreign policy.

The firm cannot recognize any regime which coerces a union of persons or of minors against their will, nor to the harm of persons based on their non-participation in such religious or heterosexual activity as do not harm or assert such views on others and against good order and the dignity of individuals.

Should the ISLAMIC EMIRATE OF AFGHANISTAN or the "Students" (Taliban) reject these obligations, we are bound by the Laws of the United States so made in treaty, a UNIFORM DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS and other rules, to disregard any orders or unlawful restraint against our legal person.

Employees shall refrain from action or public support or endorsement of such acts that shall harm the PEACE, provided the safety of persons is not violated by the government or armed forces of the Taliban or UNITED EMIRATE OF AFGHANISTAN or any party under their jurisdiction or agency.

It is with deep regret the injury done to so many has created the present circumstance, and we grieve for the loss of all who have been subjected to suffering under military occupation of the nation of Afghanistan. As we honor those who fought for independence against communism, we regard the need to remain civil in all areas of war to protect the innocent and human life from unjust force and restraint. We believe all persons who are not willing to remain in Afghanistan should be free to leave and should be freely admitted by the United States and other nations, as refugees and without degree citing the prior events and hostilities there sustained by all parties in 2001-2021.

Where those persons may not leave freely, or find refuge, the protection of the domestic state of their welfare and equal protection is a duty of all military powers. No standard is set by the prior power or justification to do less.

In this regard, we wish only for Peace and the security of the Afghan People.
